

Student Pre-Arrival

COVID Checklist



Complete a COVID test.

You pick:

- **PCR Test** - Must be completed within 72 hours of arrival
- **Rapid Test** - Must be completed within 24 hours of arrival

All tests must be medically supervised. Tests must be negative for a student to travel to campus. Medical supervision can be by telehealth, primary care, pharmacy, urgent care, or other medical service providers that can provide valid documentation.



Bring a printed copy of your negative COVID test results to campus and provide at check-in. Be sure the official results are printed.

No students will be allowed to enter the dorms or facilities until a negative test is provided.



Bring masks. Mask wearing policies are determined in collaboration with each university and may change prior to or during the program.

Some students may choose to wear masks regardless of the policy. Be respectful of individuals' choices. Students may be required to wear masks in certain locations or buildings on campus. 10 reusable or 2-3 disposable masks per day.



Strongly Recommended: Bring 1 Rapid COVID test per week you will be on campus.

We will have nurses and testing supplies on campus, but we are suggesting families supply 1 sealed test per week the student is on campus. This will allow for more rapid testing if the student needs to be tested during a non-business hour.



Be prepared for and compliant with symptomatic COVID testing during the program.

If a student has symptoms of COVID, the student will be tested by our on-campus nurse.
